**SUBJECT: STUDY ON TWO STREAMS OF ATC RATINGS.**

**NOTICE :**

AAI vide Office Order No.AAI/ATM/HRD/29-190/2017 dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2017 has constituted a Committee to review the current multiple ATC rating procedures, for the introduction of 2 stream ratings for ATCOs in Airports Authority of India which, when put in place is expected to offer important benefit, namely optimization of ATM productivity as well as compliance with the National and International Regulatory Requirements in respect of ATCOs ratings/ certification. The Committee has the following terms of reference:

- i) Review the current rating systems of ATCOs in place and identify the deficiencies;
- ii) Examine the introduction of 2 stream ratings namely Terminal and Enroute and the earliest probable date for the implementation
- iii) Training Plan for 2 stream ratings and infrastructure changes required;
- iv) Specific recommendations for addressing the imbalance in the rating / stress allowance after introduction of 2 stream rating system and the financial implications thereof;
- v) Consideration traffic load for en-route and terminal streams for determining stress allowance;
- vi) Minimum mandatory duty hours in a month for ATCOs in active channel for claiming applicable stress allowance;
- vii) Minimum number of hours of duty to be performed for keeping the currency of ratings in each A TC unit in a period of 90 days.
- viii) Use of automated scheduling and time management system to increase the efficiency as well as record absences;
- ix) Prepare a road-map for implementation of 2 stream of ATC ratings; and
- x) Any other relevant point, the Committee may like to consider.
