He joined Airports Authority of India in the year 1983, Airports Authority of India at Mumbai Airport as Airport Operation Officer.

In the years, he was promoted as Senior Manager (Operations), Asst. General Manager, Dy. General Manager at IGI Airport, New Delhi, AAI Headquarter, Kolkata Mumbai and Pune Airport.

During the posting at IGIA, New Delhi handled various VVIP / protocol duties, airside and Terminal side Management. In the year 1997 worked at Corporate Office and dealt with all India flight scheduling of all Domestic and International Airports.
