Upper age limits are relaxable by 10 years for candidates who are in regular service of AAI, subject to attainment of 50 years. d. (Visual Evaluation is for each eye individually). iii. 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<p style="text-align: center;">Disqualification</p>	<p>Physical deformity, chronic diseases, colour blindness, night blindness, squint eye, flat foot, bow legs, knocking knee and refractive error will be considered as disqualification.</p>										

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Candidates must not have undergone any major operation by virtue of which his/her physical fitness to work in fire service has been impaired. Candidates should be capable of undergoing physical strain for prolonged periods.
