using state-of-the-art technology and ensuring user-friendly environment.

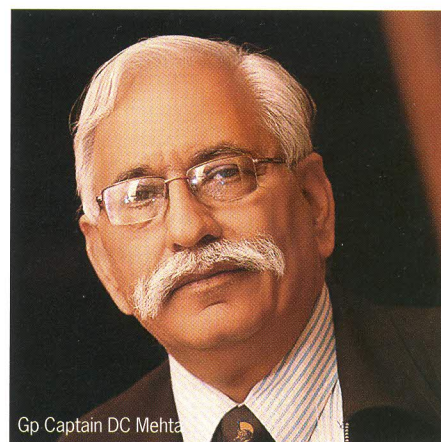
Expertise in Handling Air Cargo Operations
