

OVER ALL REVIEW OF TRAFFIC

TRAFFIC SUMMARY:

During the year 2013-14, all operational airports taken together handled 1.54 million aircraft movements (excluding general aviation movements), 168.92 million passengers and 2.28 million tonnes of freight. The details are given in Table No. 1.1.

Trends in traffic:

Following table shows the trends in traffic at AAI airports during 2013-14 Vs 2012-13.

The above table reveals that total aircraft movements, passenger and freight traffic have increased by 3.9%,6.0% and 4.0% respectively during 2013-14 as compared to the traffic handled during 2012-13.

Aircraft Movement Traffic:

- During the year 2013-14, 15.37 lakh aircraft movements were handled at all Indian airports as against 14.79 lakh movements handled during 2012-13 registering an increase of 3.9%.
- International aircraft movements have shown an increase of 7.0% during 2013-14 over 2012-13.

- Domestic aircraft movements have registered an increase of 3.1% during 2013-14 as compared to 2012-13. Domestic aircraft movement growth behind domestic passenger growth reflective of higher demand domestically for air transport but also the adoption of larger aircraft and better use of capacity.

Passenger Traffic:

- Total passenger traffic handled at all Indian airports (taken together) an increase to 168.92 million during 2013-14 as against 159.40 million during 2012-13 and has registered an increase of 6.0%.
- International passenger traffic has registered a growth of 8.3% at all airports taken together during the period under review.
- Domestic passengers handled at all airports registered an increase of 5.1% during 2013-14 over 2012-13. The Low Cost Carrier (LCC) share in domestic traffic increased to 62.7% during the year 2013-14 compared to LCC's share 60.6% during 2012-13.

Freight Traffic:

- Total freight handled during 2013-14 was 22.79 lakh tonnes as against 21.91 lakh tonnes handled during 2012-13 registering an increase of 4.0%.
- International freight witnessed an increase of 2.6% during 2013-14 over 2012-13.
- Domestic freight handled at all Indian airports has registered an increase of 6.6% during the year 2013-14 over 2012-13.
