

OVER ALL REVIEW OF TRAFFIC

TRAFFIC SUMMARY:

During the year 2014-15, all operational airports taken together handled 1.60 million aircraft movements (excluding general aviation movements), 190.13 million passengers and 2.53 million tonnes of freight. The details are given in following Table.

Trends in Traffic:

Following table shows the trends in traffic at AAI airports during 2014-15 Vs 2013-14.

The above table reveals that total aircraft movements, passenger and freight traffic have increased by 4.3%, 12.6% and 10.9% respectively during the year 2014-15 as compared to the traffic handled during 2013-14.

Aircraft Movement Traffic:

- During the year 2014-15, 1.60 million aircraft movements were handled at all Indian airports as against 1.54 million aircraft movements handled during 2013-14 registering an increase of 4.3%.
- International aircraft movements have shown an increase of 2.8% during 2014-15 over 2013-14.

- Domestic aircraft movements have registered an increase of 4.7% during 2014-15 as compared to 2013-14. Domestic aircraft movements growth behind domestic passenger growth is reflective of not only higher demand for air transport but also the adoption of larger aircraft and better use of capacity.

Passenger Traffic:

- Total passenger traffic handled at all Indian airports (taken together) has increased to 190.13 million during 2014-15 as against 168.92 million during 2013-14 and has registered a significant growth of 12.6%.
- International passenger traffic has registered a growth of 9.0% at all airports taken together during the period under review.
- Domestic passengers handled at all airports registered an increase of 13.9% during 2014-15 over 2013-14.

Freight Traffic:

- Total freight handled during 2014-15 was 2.53 million tonnes as against 2.28 million tonnes handled during 2013-14 registering an increase of 10.9%.
- International freight witnessed an increase of 6.9% during 2014-15 over 2013-14.
- Domestic freight handled at all Indian airports has registered a substantial growth of 17.8% during the year 2014-15 over 2013-14.
