

**Chennai, 31.12.2022: Sh. Gen. V.K. Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State for Civil Aviation inspected the Chennai Airport New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB- T2).**

The phase I of the state- of- the- art NITB, envisaged to meet the increasing passenger is already under final testing and trials prior to commissioning. Hon'ble minister along with Chennai team visited the new terminal building which is a mega project taken up by Airports Authority of India with an estimated cost of ₹2,467 crores.

The Chennai Airport NITB project includes integration of airside corridor for seamless flow, augmentation of airside/city side infrastructure. The NITB is 'GRIHA 4 Star' complaint (Green Rating for Integrated Habitat Assessment) with various eco-friendly materials used during the construction phase.

International Terminal T-3, with an area of 42,300 Sq. is set to be demolished and rebuilt for Phase II work after commissioning of Phase I by January 2023. The state -of -the- art New terminal which will function as one large integrated terminal for the international operations having a total area of 2,20,972 Sq. m, will enhance the present capacity of handling 17 MPPA to nearly 35 MPPA by December 2024 and will boast of the best of amenities for the passenger/users.
