Subject: Applicability of Revenue share to be charged from Ground Handling Agencies operating at AAI managed Airports.

Sir,

As per AAI Ground Handling Regulations-2018, M/s AIASL - Subsidiary of Air India & AAI appointed Ground Handling Agencies (GHAs) will provide Ground Handling Services at AAI Airports. However, few GHAs which are Non-entitled Entities (NEEs) are providing ground handling services at few airports managed by AAI pursuant to the status quo orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in (i) WP (C) No. 6406 of 2021 in Perfect Aviation Services Pvt. Ltd. Vs UOI & Ors., (ii) WP (C) No. 6432 of 2021 in Trikutta Travel Planners Vs UOI & Ors., (iii) WP (C) No. 6993 of 2021 in CAPSR Vs UOI & Ors. and (iv) WP (C) No. 10120 of 2021 in Sri Sai Sampat Aviation Handling Services Vs UOI & Ors.

2. In accordance with office letter No. COM/913/1.3/GH/Policy/Vol-XIII/2012 dated 31.07.2012 (copy enclosed), all Ground Handling Agencies operating at Airports are paying the royalty charges as per the rates mentioned in the said letter.

3. The Competent Authority has decided that the Non-entitled Entities (NEEs) operating at AAI Airports through various interim orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi shall pay uniform Revenue Share effective from the date of issue of this letter as per rates given below:

*Revenue share for RCS flights will be revised to applicable rates for respective categories of Users as mentioned in above table in case the flights are no longer covered under the Regional Connectivity Scheme.

4. The NSOPs while submitting the flight plan to respective Airport Director, shall indicate the name of the Ground Handling Agency, the Ground Handling Service charges to be paid and account details of GHAs. Airport Directors shall ensure that the Ground Handling Charges are paid by the NSOPs to Ground Handling Agencies through RTGS/Card Swapping Machine to avoid any cash transactions. To maintain transparency, no cash transaction between Airline Operator/NSOP and Ground Handling Agencies (NEEs) will be permitted with effect from the date of issue of this letter.

5. The Ground Handling Agencies (NEEs) shall provide the account details of the bank in which the Ground Handling Charges would be paid by the Airline Operator. Airport Operator/ Airport Directors shall seek the details of bank account to verify the payments received by the NEEs on account of Ground Handling services at respective airports.


6. It is clarified that issuance of this letter does not confer any right of regularization to the Non-entitled Entities (NEEs).

7. The above rates have already been implemented for (M/s AIASL) Subsidiary of M/s Air India w.e.f 01.10.2021 vide this office letter No. AAI/OPS/707/AIASL/2021/343 dated 21.09.2021.

8. List of Airports under respective category is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. The upcoming AAI Airports in future will be included in the Group D Airports.

It is in continuation of this office earlier letter no. COM/931/1.3/GH/Policy/Vol-XIII/2012 dated 27.04.2012 on the above subject.

The passes of airlines ground handling staff may be renewed up to 31.10.2012 subject to the conditions as mentioned in MOCA's letter no. AV.24087/028/2010/AAI/VOL-II dated 25.07.2012 [copy enclosed along with a copy of letter dated 28.07.2011, 25.10.2011, 18.01.2012 and 16.04.2012 for reference purposes].

In this connection reference is also invited CHO letter no. COM/931/1.1/GH/Policy/2012 dated July 12, 2012, wherein the percentage of royalty to be levied was communicated. It should be ensured that the percentage of royalty is being levied as per the CHO letter and the confirmation in this regard may also be communicated.

It is once again reiterated that percentage of Royalty to be charged at airports on non-entitled entities will be:-

Chennai Airport	: 32.5% on G.T.O.
Kolkata Airport	: 32.5% on G.T.O.
Northern Region	: 21% on G.T.O.
Southern Region	: 31.51% on G.T.O.
Western Region	: 30.3% on G.T.O.
Eastern Region	: 13% on G.T.O.
North East Region	: 13% on G.T.O.
