Subject: Introduction of Integrity Clubs as a part of Co- curricular Activities in the Council affiliated Schools

Dear Principal,

The Central Vigilance Commission, Government of India, New Delhi has set up a Vigilance Advisory Council to get a feedback on the effectiveness of the implementation of the existing guidelines as well as on the new thoughts/plans to curb corruption.

Members of the Vigilance Advisory Council were of the view that to eradicate corruption and to inculcate moral values into the minds of young children of classes VI to IX some initiatives should be taken in the form of co-curricular activities. Therefore, to rekindle values in the minds of young children and to make them socially and morally responsible citizens of the country the Central Vigilance Commission, Government of India has desired that the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi should introduce such activities in their affiliated schools. Therefore, to sensitize students and make them aware of life skills to counter excessive influence of television, the internet and cellphones, all the affiliated schools to the CISCE are advised to Introduce Integrity Clubs in their schools as Community Groups for cultivating human values among students by organizing games, activities and workshops.
