**AN INCENTIVE SCHEME ON LANDING CHARGES FOR INTERNATIONAL TRANSIT & TECHNICAL CARGO FREIGHTERS AT CHENNAI AND KOLKATA AIRPORTS**

**New Delhi, 08<sup>th</sup> July 2015:** In order to encourage the Airlines to bring more cargo freighters into Chennai and Kolkata Airports, AAI has brought an unique incentive scheme in landing charges for international transit and technical cargo freighters operated by the airlines to and from Kolkata and Chennai Airports. The incentive on landing charges for cargo freighters is linked to the frequency of the number of freighters operated in a month at these two airports.

The broad details

<b>No. of Cargo Freighters in a month</b>	<b>% concession on applicable landing / charges on freighters</b>
1 – 5	NIL
6-10	10% - From 1 to 10
11-15	10% - From 1 to 10 20% - from 11 to 15
16 and above	10% - From 1 to 10 20%- from 11 to 15 30%- from 16 and above

The above scheme is applicable for Chennai and Kolkata Airports only for all International scheduled and non-scheduled cargo freighters which is valid for initial period of 3 years.
