LEVY AND COLLECTION OF AVIATION SECURITY FEE (ASF) AT INDIAN AIRPORTS.

In exercise of power conferred under Rule 88A of the Aircraft Rules, 1937, the central government has accorded approval for levy of revised Aviation Security Fee (ASF) rates on air tickets issued w.e.f 1st September,2020 as under:

- i. Aviation Security Fee for domestic passengers will be levied at the rate of Rs. 160/- per embarking passenger.
 - ii. Aviation Security Fee for international passengers will be levied at the rate of US\$ 5.20 or equivalent Indian rupees per embarking passenger.
2. The exemption as applicable earlier on the following categories of persons will continue:
- (i) Children (under age of 2 years),
 - (ii) Holders of Diplomatic Passport,
 - (iii) Airlines crew on duty including sky marshals & airline crew on board for the particular flight only (this would not include Dead Head Crew, or ground personnel),

- (iv) Persons travelling on official duty on aircraft operated by IAF,
- (v) Persons travelling on official duty for United Nations Peace Keeping Missions,
- (vi) Transit / transfer passengers (this exemption may be granted to all the passengers transiting up to 24 hrs. "A passenger is treated in transit only if onward travel journey is within 24 hrs from arrival into airport and is part of the same ticket. In case two separate tickets are issued, it would not be treated as a transit passenger"),
- (vii) Passenger departing from any Airport due to involuntary re-routing i.e. technical problems or weather conditions.
