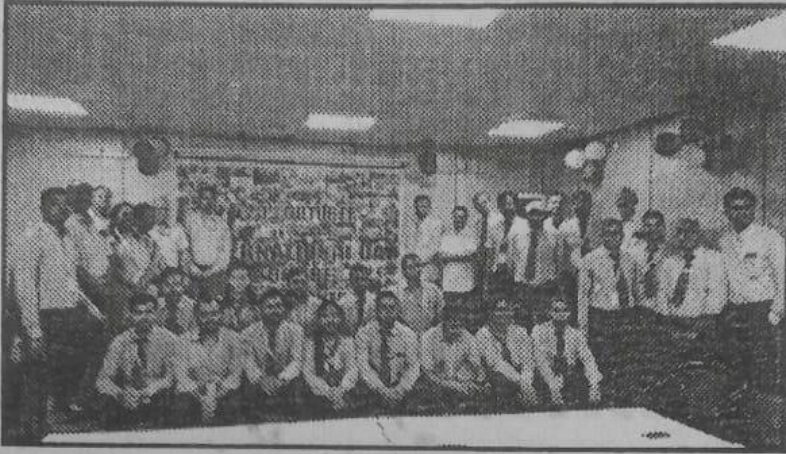
विश्व वायु यातायात नियंत्रक दिवस
