

## **SIGNING OF MoA's**



**Recently AAI has signed following 2 Nos. of MoA's:**

### **1. Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society (SVHMS).**

Airports Authority of India (AAI) & Swami Vivekanand Health Mission Society signed a MoA on dated 08.04.2025 regarding ***“Establishment of MRI Machine and Digital Mammography at Dharmawala, Dehradun, Uttarakhand”*** for amounting to ***Rs. 9.51 Crores***. MRI machine will be used for screening of patients suffering from spine, Neuro, Nephro etc. problems and Digital Mammography machine will be used for advance screening of breast cancer.



## 2. India Turns Pink (ITP).

Airports Authority of India (AAI) & India Turns Pink (ITP) signed a MoA on dated 03.04.2025 regarding ***“Breast Cancer Screening through the use of I Breast Device (SEWA Project) Pune, Visakhapatnam, Varanasi, Srinagar, Guwahati, and Srikakulam”*** for amounting to **Rs. 80.40 Lakhs.**

The project shall cover 60,000 women covering 60 villages (10 villages each location) with a target to cover 1000 women per village. The screening will be provided free of cost to all 60,000 women.
