

## **SIGNING OF MoA's**

AAI's CSR initiatives aim to support the community and environment where we operate, focusing on areas like healthcare, education, Community development. Airports Authority of India (A.A.I.) has undertaken CSR projects/ programs on various subjects and areas identified in Schedule VII.

**Recently AAI has signed following 4 Nos. of MoA's under its CSR initiatives:**

### **1. Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation (ALIMCO).**

Airports Authority of India (AAI) & Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation (ALIMCO) signed a MoA on dated 02.05.2025 regarding ***“Distribution of assistive living devices to divyangjans in Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh” for amounting to Rs. 2.18 Crores.***

#### **❖ Objectives: -**

- The project shall be implemented by Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO).
- ALIMCO shall carry out distribution of aids & appliances in Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh to around 665 persons with disability from deprived class of society free of cost.



## 2. Bhagwan Mahaveer Child Welfare Trust (BMCWT).

Airports Authority of India (AAI) & Bhagwan Mahaveer Child Welfare Trust (BMCWT) signed a MoA on dated 15.05.2025 regarding ***“Establishment of 60 single teacher school initiative for underprivileged children in Rajasthan”*** for amounting to ***Rs. 54.00 Lakhs.***

### ❖ Objectives: -

- To provide free primary education to children in slum, rural and tribal areas through a sustainable model of single-teacher schools.
- The initiative will reach approximately 1200 children at Jaipur, Sikar & Udaipur in Rajasthan.



### 3. Bisnouli Sarvodaya Gramodyog Sewa Sansthan (BSGSS).

**Airports Authority of India (AAI) & Bisnouli Sarvodaya Gramodyog Sewa Sansthan (BSGSS)** signed a MoA on dated 09.05.2025 regarding "Assistance of ₹98,00,400 for Community health programme (Jan Arogyam) in the aspirational district of Haridwar (Uttarakhand), to be Implemented by Bisnouli Sarvodaya Gramodyog Sewa Sansthan (BSGSS) amounting to Rs. 98,00,400/-.

#### ❖ Objectives: -

- To provide better healthcare facilities to the needy and underserved populations.
- Procurement, installation of medical equipments & accessories, furniture & fixtures & electronic items which includes a pathology lab for Setting up of well-equipped 'Jan Arogyam Kendra' (Health Centre)
- To provide regular free OPD consultation services with medicines and supplements. The Center shall be running for 24 days in month providing its services to minimum 60 patients in a day.



#### 4. Nalanda Education & Charitable Trust.

**Airports Authority of India (AAI) & Nalanda Education & Charitable Trust** signed a MoA on dated 16.05.2025 regarding “to upgrade the infrastructure by providing Smart classrooms & Digital Labs (Smart Board, Projector, Wi-Fi, Computers & Stem Kits, Teacher Trainings & E learning resources) & upgradation & renovation of classrooms to selected 10nos. of Government schools and schools for disabled children at Gandhinagar & Vadnagar, Gujarat” amounting to Rs. 2.10 Cr.

- Upgradation of school infrastructure in 10nos. of government schools: 5 in Vadnagar & 5 in Gandhinagar.
