PAYMENT OF DIVIDEND BY AAI FOR THE YEAR 2009-10,
2nd Nov. 2010, New Delhi,

Airports Authority of India (AAI) is a Mini Ratna Category - I organization of the Ministry of Civil Aviation and it has been making profits since its inception. For the financial year 2009-10, AAI earned revenue of Rs.4615 crores (Previous Year Rs.4186 crores) and profit before tax Rs.1228 crores (Previous Year Rs.1116 crores) and profit after tax Rs.712 crores (Previous Year Rs.687 crores) has paid Dividend of Rs.142.50 crores (Previous Year Rs.137.40 crores) to the Government of India. In the process of modernizing its airport terminals, passengers facilities and Air Traffic and Navigational

Aids, AAI spent a sum of Rs.2743 crores in the year 2009-10 (Previous Year Rs.2548 crores) which is also the highest Capital Expenditure incurred so far by AAI.

Cheque for Final Dividend of Rs.142.50 crores was presented to Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation by Sh. V. P. Agrawal, Chairman, AAI in the presence of Secretary, Civil Aviation. Other senior officials of Ministry and AAI were also present.
