Sub:- Implementation of Integrity Pact in AAI – Nomination of
Independent External Monitors (IEM) reg.

The Integrity Pact (IP) had been implemented in AAI w.e.f. 01.04.2008 in order to ensure transparency, equity and competitiveness in public procurement under the guidance and specific approval of the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), and various Independent External Monitors were appointed by AAI during the period. The role of the IEMs is very important in ensuring implementation of IP.

Integrity Pact, as a vigilance tool, first promoted by the Transparency International, has been found to be useful. The CVC in its various Circulars has emphasized the necessity to adopt IP in Government organizations in their major procurement activities. The Pact envisages an Agreement between the prospective bidders and the public authorities committing the persons / officials of both the parties not to exercise any corrupt influence on any aspect of the contract. In fact, entering into this Pact would be a preliminary qualification. Only those bidders, who have entered into such an Integrity Pact with the public authorities, would be competent to participate in the bidding.

As per MoCA letter No.AV/24033/1/2013-AAI dated 17th May, 2013 followed with this office Circular of even reference dated 27th May, 2013, the threshold value for the projects for appointment of IEMs is as under:-

S. No.	Contracts	Threshold values
(i)	Civil /Electrical/Composite Works	Rs. 25.00 Crores & above
(ii)	CNS/Electronics/Tech/IT Works	Rs. 05.00 Crores & above
(iii)	Land / Commercial Contracts	Rs. 05.00 Crores.& above
(iv)	Procurement of Stores, such as Uniform, Housekeeping items, Stationary etc.	Rs 01.00 Crore & above
(v)	Project on B.O.O basis (New DOP approved by AAI Board on 27 th Dec.2012)	Rs 01.00 Crore & above

It is requested that hereinafter, the names of both the above said IEMs shall be incorporated as mandatory and specifically in the terms and conditions of the tender documents for the works under Integrity Pact and a line in its confirmation alongwith a copy of NIT may be forwarded to PM&QA Directorate as the Nodal Directorate for information and updation to ensure that the parties concerned are bound by the recommendation of the IEMs in case any complaint relating to the contract is found substantiated.

Henceforth, the procedure for nomination of IEM for various works / contracts followed, so far, in AAI as per the PM&QA Dte. letters No.AAI/PMQA/7001/ dated 15th February, 2008 [clause (e)] and No.AAI/PMQA/7001/163-131 dated 28th March, 2008 shall be discontinued with immediate effect and no request for nomination of IEM will be entertained by PM&QA Directorate hereinafter because of the above decision. It shall be the responsibility of the tender inviting authority to incorporate IP alongwith two names of the said IEMs as per threshold values prescribed.

The Integrity Pact (revised format) in respect of a particular contract would be effective from the stage of invitation of bids till the complete execution of the contract. Details / basic guidelines recommended and provided by CVC for its implementation in respect of major procurement have already been circulated by the PM&QA Directorate and are available on AAI Website (path: Others – Vigilance – Integrity Pact and on Inforsaarthee (Path: Chairman – PM&QA).
