New Delhi, 21st October, 2015: Airports Authority of India have recently issued guidelines for keeping the Donation / Charity Boxes at airports by the recognized charitable agency / organization/trust for social /economic upliftment of under privileged sections of society.

The placement of boxes will be for a period of four months initially and only one box is allowed in one terminal by the agency and not more than three boxes will be allowed in one Terminal.

The boxes should be of transparent material and placed where maximum traffic is experienced without hindering the passenger flow and no private business sponsorship or tie up arrangement should be entertained.
