


Chairman's New Year Message - 2018

AAI Signs MoU with Tata Memorial Centre for providing aid to underprivileged children suffering from Cancer

As part of the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives, Juhu Airport of Airports Authority of India signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai and has given Rs. 1.32 Crore as a financial aid towards the procurement of



specialised equipment needed for treatment of destitute children suffering from Cancer.

The number of Cancer cases is increasing rapidly in India and it is estimated by medical experts that by 2030 there will be nearly 2 million new cancer cases diagnosed in our country which may comprise large segment of paediatric oncology. To fight with this epidemic, Airports Authority of India, Juhu Airport, Mumbai, has decided to stand by Tata Memorial Centre (TMC), Mumbai to support them through following two CSR projects which includes the provision of Rs. 1 Crore for complete financial adoption of underprivileged children suffering from cancer at Tata Memorial Centre (TMC) and 31.38 Lakhs for procurement of Tape Station High-throughput Machine for the Department of Med-Oncology-Molecular Laboratory, TMC, Mumbai. Tape Station High-throughput Machine will help to check DNA/RNA quality which is required at multiple steps during the processing of the material for doing the Next Generation Sequencing (NGS) to make a proper diagnosis of Cancer and to enable doctors to give "Targeted Therapies" in this era of "Precision Medicine".

The MoU for the above CSR project was signed by Dr. M.K. Bimal, Airport Director, Juhu Airport, Mumbai and Dr. Shripad D. Banavali, Professor and Head, Department of Medical & Paediatric Oncology, TMC in the gracious presence of Shri Keshav Sharma, Regional Executive Director (WR), Mumbai; Dr. Rajan Badwe, Director, TMC and Prof. K.S. Sharma, Director (Academics), TMC and other senior officials of AAI and TMC.

Supply of classroom infrastructure to Madhya Vidyalaya, Manoharpur, Patna under CSR

Madhya Vidyalaya Manoharpur, Co-education, school (middle) situated in Kanouji, Kachhuara Panchayat, Sampatchak block of Patna district was visited by Airport Director, Patna, a year back and found that students (with majority

Kalyanmayee conducts Cervical Screening Camp at Bhubaneswar

Airports Authority of India as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has taken up initiatives to conduct Cervical Screening Camps for women aged between 30-60 years from under privileged /un-insured section of society. The first camp was organized at Kargil Basti in Bhubaneswar on 10th December, 2017 by Kalyanmayee, Airports Authority of India Women Welfare Organisation (AAIWWA) in association with Asia - Oceania Research Organization on Genital Infections and Neoplasia, India (AOGIN). The camp witnessed overwhelming response and nearly 60 women were screened.

Kalyanmayee will be organising screening camps at Delhi, Lucknow, Varanasi, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Bengaluru and Coimbatore in Northern, Western, Eastern and Southern regions, respectively. Around 7,200 underprivileged women are expected to benefit from such camps. Bolstering its CSR activities, AAI has taken several steps to sustain and empower under-privileged communities near its airports and provide necessary help in socio-economic development.

AAI is working in health, sanitation, paper recycling, towards encouraging rural sports and education & skill development.



AAICLAS launches international cargo facility at Madurai Airport

The international cargo terminal at Madurai Airport was formally inaugurated by Shri Guruprasad Mohapatra, Chairman, Airports Authority of India (AAI) on 28th November, 2017.

The facility launched by AAICLAS (AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company) will facilitate export of fruits, vegetables, flowers, textile and other products from the southern districts.



Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Mohapatra said that all facilities for the international cargo terminal, including those for handling perishable goods, would be provided.

The international cargo facility has come up on a 500 Sq. m. area with an advanced X-Ray machine with dual imaging, strong room, dangerous goods shed, e-weighing machine, security features like hand-held and door frame metal detectors and closed circuit television camera network, said.

Collector Shri K. Veera Raghava Rao, Shri S. Sreekumar, Regional Executive Director (SR), Airport Director Shri V.V. Rao and Shri B.K. Mehrotra, General Manager (Cargo) were present. The new facility is expected to provide a big boost to the economic development of the region.

Health check-up camp and diabetes awareness talk on the occasion of World Diabetes Day – 2017


On the occasion of World Diabetes Day, 14th November, Mangaluru International Airport in collaboration with Indiana Hospital and Heart Institute Ltd (IHHI)



hosted an awareness campaign on Diabetes which included a free health check-up camp in the new international terminal building of Mangaluru International Airport. The health checkup camp was held on 14th November, 2017 from 0930 hrs. to 1530 hrs. The World Diabetes Day focused on the theme of 'Women and Diabetes - our right to a healthy future'.

During the campaign more than 200 people of various profiles such as airline Passengers, taxi drivers, airline and airport staff & CISF Personnel have undertaken health screening. The free health check-up camp had an assessment of blood sugar, blood pressure and consultation by doctors from Indiana Hospital and Heart Institute. The Diabetes Awareness Campaign concluded with an interactive session - 'Preventing and Managing Diabetes and the various attributes of Diabetes' hosted by

Dr. Aditya Bharadwaj (MBBS, DNB, FRCS) of IHHI Ltd. The session was attended by AAI Personnel and staff of various airlines & agencies.



Commissioning of new Instrument Landing System (ILS) for Runway 07 at Chennai International Airport

In pursuit of augmenting the air navigation services for safety of the aircraft and travelling public, Airports Authority of India has replaced the existing Instrument Landing System (ILS) at Chennai International Airport at a cost of Rs. 5 Crores.

The ILS provides the necessary guidance to the pilots while they approach for landing at the runway. The state of the art equipment is manufactured by M/s Indra Navia AS, Norway. The new ILS will facilitate smooth landing of the aircraft at Chennai Airport during rain, low clouds, smog etc. and also will provide improved guidance to the aircraft.

The new system uses an antenna which is highly directional 'Wide Aperture Log Periodic Antenna Array [LPDA]' system. This antenna system has also mitigated the coverage restrictions of old ILS, thereby, providing guidance to the aircraft to a much lower height with improved precision and enhanced safety during landing phase of the aircraft.

The complete installation, alignment, testing, flight inspection and commissioning of the new Instrument Landing System has been done by in-house CNS technical experts of AAI.

Domestic cargo facility opens at Trivandrum Airport

Trivandrum International airport now has the Common User Domestic Cargo Terminal (CUDCT) - a facility to take care of domestic air cargo under one roof, set up by the Airports Authority of India. The 520 square foot facility cost approximately Rs 50 Lakhs to construct, became operational on 5th October, 2017.

Airlines that will use the new facility to handle their cargo include Air India, Indigo, Jet Airways and Spice Jet, all of whom operate from the domestic terminal of the airport, where the facility is located. All customs and security clearance procedures will be carried out inside the facility, with a Rs 35 Lakh X-Ray machine having been installed for cargo screening purposes.

The CUDCT was commissioned by the CEO of AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company, Shri Keku Bomi Gazder. Shri Gazder said that the aim was to move air cargo with greater speed and efficiency. "We hope to have nearly 500 tonnes of cargo movement in the first month and an increase of 15% to 20% in the coming months," he opined.



According to Airport Director George Tharakan, there should be a minimum of 200 tonne cargo transportation every day, considering the current flight movements at the airport. "Daily we have 50 flight movements at the airport. And assigning four tonnes for each flight, 200-tonne cargo movement is possible from the airport on a daily basis," Tharakan commented. "But the present cargo movement is not more than 50 tonnes per day. We hope to improve the cargo movement through the CUDCT," he concluded.

The new facility is to be managed by the AAI personnel.

Cervical Cancer Screening & Awareness Camp by Kalyanmayee in Chennai

Helping women to learn self-technique of breast examination and also further teach other women in family and check on their daughters.

Sanghi, JS (Mitigation), NDMA, Dr. A.K. Singh, Director, INMAS, Shri. G. Chandramouli, Airport Director,
