Corporate HRM Circular – 35 /2011

Sub: Medical benefits to the dependents under AAI (Retired Employees) Medical Benefit Scheme.

Reference CPC No.1/2010 dated 11.1.2010 whereby the condition of income limit of dependency for medical purposes has been enhanced from ₹1500/- to ₹3500/- per month.

2. In this context, it is clarified that spouse of the deceased employee whose income is more than ₹3500/- per month is eligible to get the medical card under AAI(Retired Employees) Medical Benefit Scheme whether or not compassionate appointment has been made to the ward. However, the total limit / ceiling for outdoor treatment for both ie. the spouse of the deceased employee and the ward who has been appointed on compassionate ground, will be restricted to the entitlement of the ward. The spouse of the deceased employee in such cases will be treated as dependent on the ward only.
