

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SECOND STAGE OF SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE POST OF
JUNIOR ASSISTANT(FIRE SERVICE)**

Reference is made to Notification(Advertisement No SR/01/2018 –Recruitment of Junior Assistant(fire service) in Southern region)

On the basis of performance in the written test held on 20/10/2018 for the post of Junior Assistant (FS) in Airports Authority of India, the following candidates (GEN/OBC scored 50 and above marks, SC/ST- scored 40 and above marks) are being called to appear for the Physical Measurement Test followed by Driving Test, and Physical Endurance Test. The intimation regarding Venue and date for the IInd stage will be intimated through call letter through SMS/E mail alert.

The details of the tests are as follows.

② The candidate should meet the following criteria.

(a) Educational qualification : 10th Pass + 3 years' Approved regular Diploma in Mechanical / Automobile / Fire with minimum 50% marks (or) 12th Pass (Regular Study) with 50% marks.

(b) Driving License.

Valid HMV

or

Valid MMV issued

one year before the date of advertisement ie 13.06.2018

or

Valid LMV issued

Two years before the date of advertisement ie 13.06.2018

EYE SIGHT: (Both Men and Women candidates)

Distance Vision – 6/6 At Both Eyes Without Glasses.

Near Vision – N5 In Both Eyes Without Glasses.(Visual evaluation is for each eye individually)

Colour Vision – Should be normal as determined by Ishihara's charts.

Night blindness – Absent

Field of vision – Each eye should have full field of vision(Visual evaluation is for each eye individually) as determined by confrontation test

Hearing – Normal

Speech – Normal

Refractive error – No refractive error is acceptable

Hill area candidates , Relaxation of 3 cms in height (for both Male and Female candidates) and chest measurements(only for male candidates) and proportionate relaxation in weight will be allowed to hilly area candidates on production of bonafide certificates. However, minimum chest expansion must be 5 cms (for male candidates) . No other relaxation will be allowed to any other category.

Disqualification – Knocking knees, bow legs, degree of squint, flat foot, physical deformity, suffering from chronic disease, any major operation by virtue of which his physical fitness to work in Fire Service has been impaired will be considered as disqualification.

Please bring the following certificates in originals/Xerox copy mentioned below –

- ◆ Relevant Educational Qualification Certificates as per advertisement
- ◆ Valid HMV/MMV/LMV License for verification (in original).
- ◆ Original Valid Community Certificate in the prescribed format for OBC (Clearly stating Non-Creamy Layer Status) and community certificate in respect of SC/ST candidates .
- ◆ Copy of Application registered online .
- ◆ Individual Admit Card issued for written exam.
- ◆ Candidates who are working in Central / State Govt. / PSUs / Local bodies, should produce 'No Objection Certificate' to appear for selection.
- ◆ Ex-Servicemen candidates should produce +2 ,Diploma in Mechanical Engg. equivalent certificate issued by Defense Authorities and retired / discharge certificate.
- ◆ Domicile/Residence certificate
- ◆ One set of visible Photostat Copies of above documents.
- ◆ Two Passport size photographs same as submitted at the time of registration.
- ◆ Pen.
- ◆ Vests ,Shorts and track suits / Half Knickers, T shirts (at the time of Physical Measurement / Endurance Test).

If any Candidate failed to bring the originals and Xerox copies of the above said certificates for verification, he/she will be debarred/rejected from appearing for the next stage of selection. His/ Her candidature for further selection process will be summarily rejected. Candidates who are domicile of States/Union Territories (Tamilnadu, AndhraPradesh, Karnataka, Telegana, Kerala, Pondichery, Lakswweep islands) shall only attend the tests. Candidates who are domicile of others States/UTs, other than mentioned above shall be summarily rejected in the certificate verification process..

⑥ The test shall consist of the following (each one being elimination round).

(A) Physical Measurement Test.

The authorized doctors from Govt/AAI empanelled hospital will examine the Physical standards as per para (3) above at the venue. Candidates declared "UNFIT" by the medical board will not be allowed to appear for further stage of selection process.

(B) Driving test.

Candidates qualified in the Physical Measurement test shall be eligible subject to driving test using LIGHT Motor vehicles. Candidate declared 'FAIL' by the Examiner will not be allowed to appear for further stage of selection process

(C) Endurance test. : Candidates who pass driving test will only be allowed to appear for endurance test consisting of the following tests.

4	Casualty lifting	40 Kg weight	Carry the human dummy of 40 kg weight for 30 mtrs away & bring it back safely in 45 seconds.
5	Ladder climbing	6 Metres height	Maximum of 120 seconds

Each of the above Physical Endurance test contains 20 marks and totaling 100 marks . Minimum pass mark is 60/100.

Note. Candidates who do not meet the above mentioned requirements need not to attend the tests.
