Payment of final Dividend by AAI for the year 2013-14

New Delhi, 2nd July 2015 The Airports Authority of India (AAI), a consistently profit making organization since its inception, declared a dividend of Rs. 288 crores for the year 2013-14. An interim dividend cheque amounting to Rs. 145 crores was already presented to Ministry of Civil Aviation on 4th August, 2014.

Today (2nd July, 2015), a cheque towards final dividend of Rs. 143 crores was presented by Shri R K Srivastava, IAS, Chairman, AAI to the Hon'ble Union Minister of Civil Aviation in the presence of Sh. R. N. Choubey, Secretary (CA).

Speaking on the occasion, the Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation complemented the Airports Authority of India for its financial achievements. The Secretary, Civil Aviation also extended his compliments and best wishes to AAI for its continued growth.

AAI earned a revenue of Rs. 8170 crores generating a profit before tax of Rs. 2520 crores. It has declared Dividend of Rs.288 crores to the Government of India for the year 2013-14. AAI have spent Rs. 4358 crores during the last three years (2012-13 to 2014-15) on modernization of Airport Terminals, Passengers Facilities and Air Traffic & Navigational Aids at its airports and has planned to spend this year Rs. 2000 crores.

AAI have paid Rs.768.10 crores as Dividend in the last five years and have also contributed to the Central exchequer Rs. 3481 crores in different forms during the last three years (2011-12 to 2013-14) apart from paying Dividend.

Senior officers from Ministry of Civil Aviation as well as Airports Authority of India were also present on this occasion.
