New Integrated Terminal Building at Vadodara Airport dedicated to the nation by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India

New Integrated Terminal Building at Vadodara Airport has been dedicated to the Nation on 22nd October, 2016 by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in the august presence of Shri O.P. Kohli, Governor of Gujarat, Shri Vijay Rupani, Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri P. Ashok Gajapathi Raju, Union Minister of Civil Aviation, Shri Jayant Sinha, Union Minister of State for Civil Aviation, Shri Nitinbhai Patel, Deputy Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri Rajendra Suryaprasad Trivedi, Minister of State for Sports, Youth Cultural Activities(i/c), Pilgrimage Development, Govt. of Gujarat, Shri R.N. Choubey, Secretary Civil Aviation, Dr. Guruprasad Mohapatra, Chairman Airports Authority of India and other dignitaries. The Hon'ble Prime Minister took a walk through of the new facility and unveiled plaque in the Arrival area of the building.



The New Integrated Terminal Building is capable of handling 700 passengers (500 domestic and 200 international) during the peak hour. The terminal building has been constructed having total area of 17500sqm with land area of 630.60 acres. The terminal building is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities such as CUTE check-in counters, Reserved Lounge, C.I.P.Lounge, Glass cleaning system in Air & city side façade, Escalators, Elevators, Sewerage Treatment Plant with Zero Waste, Rain Water Harvesting, Energy Efficient Glass, a Unique Food Court outside Terminal Building & Car Parking, etc. It is in the Limca Book of Records for having 164.2 Meter length single roof sheets used on the roof top. On the air side of the airport, Apron and taxi track are available. Apron is capable of parking 13 nos. aircraft. The New Integrated Terminal Building has been constructed at a total cost of Rs. 160 crores. The New Integrated Terminal to a great extent cater to the passenger facilities be it comfort, convenience, aesthetics, eco-friendliness and so on. The facility will immensely contribute towards tourism in the State in particular and give impetus to economic development of the region.
