There are some media reports with reference to Airports Authority of India (AAI) that AAI has sought details regarding Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) stock positions at international airports in the context of the prevailing geopolitical situation in West Asia.

AAI categorically denies these reports. The Airports Authority of India states that **it has not asked formally or informally any airport operator to furnish details regarding fuel stocks or estimated fuel requirements.** The reports suggesting such communication are false and factually incorrect.

It is further reiterated that AAI functions strictly within its defined mandate. The AAI is airport operator and navigation service provider. It does not exercise oversight over fuel inventories.

AAI remains committed to the safe, secure, and efficient management of airport infrastructure. Hence AAI advises against the circulation of unverified, false and factually incorrect information.
