Review Status of Airports in Gujarat in the wake of Cyclone Vayu

New Delhi, 13th June, 2019: A Review Meeting for checking the status of AAI airports in Gujarat in the wake of Cyclone Vayu was held today through a Video Conference at Corporate HQ, New Delhi.

As per the status updates given by the Airport Directors of the airports in the state, it was observed that the effect of Cyclone Vayu has been milder at most of the airports of Gujarat. No damage to any airport infrastructure or facilities has been reported so far. Situation is normal at Surat, Bhuj, Keshod, Kandla, Jamnagar, Vadodara and Ahmedabad. Diu, Porbandar and Bhavnagar Airports that are currently witnessing a wind speed between 30 to 40 km/hr gusting up to 60 km/hr have been asked to closely monitor the situation and take note of Meteorological data.

The next Review Meeting has been scheduled for the afternoon today and looking at the situation then, action on reviewing NOTAM and resumption of flights will be taken.
