**Sub: Fixation of space licence fee rates at New Integrated Terminal Building at Anna International Airport, Chennai**

Sir,

This is with reference to the above subject.

In its 204<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25.10.2011 wherein CAB after considering the licence fee being charged at Bangaluru International Airport and Hyderabad International Airport and the cost of upgradation of the new international building and the maintenance upwards decided to fix the space rental for space rent at Chennai Airport is given below:

Air conditioned area	Non air-conditioned area	Ticketing counters	Exclusive Airline Lounge
Rs. 1250/- per Sqm. per month	Rs. 700/- per Sqm. per month	Rs. 2250/- per Sqm. per month	Rs. 3500/- per Sqm. per month

CAB also decided the following:

- The annual rate of escalation will be 7.5% every year as per the present policy approved by the Board.
- The above rates will be implemented w.e.f. 1/4/2012 or actual occupation by the licensee, whichever is earlier.
- The above rates will be valid for a period of three years.
