Information Sought (जानकारी मांगी):	<p>To The Central Public Information Officer Airports Authority of India Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, Safdarjung Airport New Delhi 110003</p> <p>Subject: Request for Information Regarding Permission to Access Indoor and Outdoor Location Access within Airport Premises</p> <p>Respected Sir/Madam,</p> <p>Under Section 6(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, I seek detailed information regarding the process and required permissions to access indoor and outdoor location access at airports managed by the Airports Authority of India (AAI).</p> <p>Recent directives from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) have underscored the urgent need to strengthen infrastructure and ensure compliance in the management of wheelchair services at Indian airports. With upcoming policy changes, airlines face growing operational challenges in ensuring real-time, accountable, and transparent passenger assistance.</p> <p>In response, IndiGo Airlines (InterGlobe Aviation Ltd.) has initiated</p>		

a nationwide implementation of a smart wheelchair tracking and inspection system in collaboration with OMFYS Technologies. This solution leverages GPS and Bluetooth Beacon technologies to provide:

- 1) Real-time indoor and outdoor tracking of wheelchair assets
- 2) Digitized inspections through mobile apps with centralized cloud-based reporting
- 3) Predictive analytics to optimize asset allocation and procurement
- 4) A user-friendly dashboard for seamless monitoring and control

To ensure successful deployment, we are requesting permission to access indoor location infrastructure, including beacon networks, terminal floor plans, and geofencing capabilities necessary for effective indoor positioning.

Accordingly, I request the following information under the RTI Act:

1) What is the official procedure to obtain permission for accessing indoor geolocation infrastructure (e.g., indoor positioning systems, beacon networks, floor plans) at AAI-operated airports?

2) What approvals or regulatory compliances are required to access outdoor geo-mapping data (including GPS-based systems) for asset tracking on airport premises?

3) Which department or authority within AAI oversees these permissions and coordinates with private entities?

4) Are there specific forms, NDAs, data-sharing agreements, or security clearances that need to be submitted?

5) Is there any applicable fee, licensing condition, or compliance requirement under NCASP or related aviation security programs?

We are happy to furnish any additional technical documentation, proposals, or a live system demonstration upon request.
