Kindly refer enclosure 1 letter from Executive Director (Plg), CHQ, AAI. AAI cannot take any step against the State Govt. for delay in resolving the land acquisition issue.</p> <p>2) There was no such project for constructing a new Integrated Terminal building in Silchar Airport in the year 2007.</p> <p>3) Development of new Greenfield Airport at Silchar is highly cost intensive proposition. Reference is invited to Letter No. CLA 48/2013/18 dated 13th January addressed to Regional Executive Director (North East Region) on the above mentioned subject.

The issue regarding new Greenfield Airport at Silchar has been reviewed by AAI and AAI is of the view that creation of new infrastructure would take very long time and Silchar Airport needs urgent upgradation of Civil Enclave. Therefore Assam Govt may reconsider AAI request for 116.5 acres at Kumbhirgram

In view of feedback on land acquisition from State Administration, AAI has revised the Master Plan with land acquisition of 116.5 acres of Kumbhirgram Airport against 158 acres (copy enclosed). although the air-side access is constrained and for access to proposed civil enclave, taxi track would need to be constructed through 41.5 acre land being acquired by IAF. For implementation of the revised Master Plan, a joint meeting with State Govt. and Air force officials may please be conducted.

It would be appreciated that development of new Greenfield Airport is highly cost intensive proposition. In order to evaluate the suitability of the proposed site suggested by Assam Govt. approval of AAI Consultancy fee amounting to Rs. 11,66,105/- (Rs eleven lakhs, sixty six thousand, one hundred and five only) for Site selection and preliminary visit of the team may please be communicated for further action.

AAI is also considering some short term modification proposal for existing Terminal Building to ease the congestion.
