1.0 PREAMBLE:

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Sh. Kalpesh Angavalkar had submitted RTI application dated 31.01.2023 seeking information regarding ‘ Land bearing survey no. 134 & 135 village Marol Taluka: Andheri, Zilla: Mumbai-Suburban.
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/ आरटीआय/केस-37/2023(एम)/39 dated 06.02.2023 provided information to the applicant.
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 03.03.2023 before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai.

3.0 FINDINGS &ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal and the case details, it is observed that the appellant vide his RTI application dated 31.01.2023 had sought documents with respect to land bearing survey no. 134 & 135 village Marol Taluka: Andheri, Zilla: Mumbai-Suburban. As Deptt. of Land is the Deemed PIO, therefore RTI application was forwarded to Jt. GM (LM), WR. Accordingly vide ION no. AAB/LM/RTI/Kalpesh Angavalkar/164(208)/ dated 03.02.2023 Jt. GM (LM), WR informed stating that “The Collector (MSD) is the Acquisition Authority for the CSI Airport land and the custodian of all land acquisition documents.” The said reply was subsequently communicated to the appellant vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-37)2023/एम/(39 dated 06.02.2023. Aggrieved by the response received, the appellant has filed first appeal. The deemed PIO (Jt. G. M.-L.M,WR) vide its ION dated 14.03.2023 has clarified that none of the original documents sought by the appellant are available with

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the department, only photo copies of the two documents (1) G.R no. 5354/51 dated 19.09.1952 and (2) G.R. no. 5354/51/116654-H dated 27.11.1958 are available. Hence the information sought by the appellant is not available with AAI and pertains to the office of Mumbai Suburban District, custodian of which is the Collector, MSD, Mumbai. However the photocopies of the above available photocopies can be given to the appellant. Therefore RTI application as well as the first appeal in the instant case is hereby transferred under section 6(3) of RTI Act to The Collector (MSD), Mumbai being the Acquisition Authority for CSI Airport and Custodian of the said acquisition documents.

3.2 With the above observations, the Appeal dated 03.03.2023 of Sh. Kalpesh Angavalkar hereby stands disposed off.
