1.0 PREAMBLE:

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Sh. Ram Prasad Sharma had submitted RTI application no. AAIMU/R/E/23/00025 dated 20.02.2023 seeking information regarding ‘
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/ आरटीआय/केस-76/2023(एम)/95 dated 13.03.2023 provided information to the applicant.
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/23/00016 dated 15.03.2023 before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai.

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

- 1) The Appellant (Roll No 131300600037) had applied for the post of Junior Assistant (Fire Services) NE-04 under Ex-Serviceman Sub Category against the above mentioned recruitment vide his application number-AAIWR003562. The online exam was conducted on 21 December 2022 for the above mentioned post.
- 2) Further, it is stated by the appellant that he had obtained 47.500 percentage (out of 100) as per the Airport Authority of India result published on AAI website dated 17 February 2023. Cut off percentage for the post of Junior Assistant (Fire Services) NE-04 (ESM) was 42.500 (out of 100) for the further process of recruitment declared by Airport Authority of India vide published on AAI website on 17 February 2023.

3) It is further intimated that despite obtaining the higher percentage than cut off percentage he has not been shortlisted for the further process of recruitment which is alleged as injustice to the appellant. In view of the above the appellant has sought the following information pertaining to the above mentioned examination under the RTI act 2005

(a) On which aspect the appellant has not been shortlisted for the further process of selection.

(b) List of shortlisted candidate for the post of Junior Assistant (Fire Services) NE-04 under Ex-Serviceman Sub Category with their percentage marks (out of 100).

3.2 **FINDINGS:**

It is seen that vide point nos. 1 & 2, the appellant has not sought any information. Therefore PIO, WR has rightly informed the same to the appellant. Therefore no direction to PIO, WR is required on these points.

Vide point no. 3 (a) the appellant is seeking reason for not shortlisting him for further process of selection. However the Public Authority cannot provide the reasons i.e. why certain thing is done or not done in the form of query. Seeking reasons do not fall under the ambit of the RTI Act. As such, a public authority can only provide information as defined in the term 'information' under Section 2 (f) of the RTI Act, 2005. Therefore no directions to PIO, WR is required on this point. As regards point 3(b), the appellant is seeking list of shortlisted candidates with their percentage marks. However, under RTI act, the appellant can seek his own marks, while marks of other candidates is a third party information which is exempted under section 8 1(j) of RTI Act and hence no information can be provided to the appellant. Therefore no direction to PIO, WR is required on this point.

3.3 **ORDER :**

With the above observations, the Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/23/00016 dated 15.03.2023 of Sh. Ram Prasad Sharma hereby stands disposed off.
