1.0 PREAMBLE

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Smt. Padmaja Mishra had submitted RTI application dated 29.01.2025 to PIO, WR regarding Reversion policy in AAI.
- 2.2 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 20.02.2025 before First Appellate Authority, RHQ, WR, Mumbai.

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

The applicant has sought information regarding Reversion policy in AAI.

3.2 FINDINGS:

From the records produced it is seen that applicant has sought information as under (1) Is it permissible under organizations policy for non-executive employee promoted or switched to another department (Ops, Finance, CNS)

through a departmental examination to request reversion to their previous post or cadre? (2) If reversion is permitted, what is the procedure an employee must follow to initiate such request? (3) Will an employee retain their seniority in the previous cadre if reversion is approved? Are there specific time limits under which seniority may be retained or affected? (4) Is there a specific time frame which an employee must request reversion to their previous post? (5) Has the organization approved any requests for reversion in the past five years? (6) Copies of policy documents, rules, or circulars governing the reversion process. In this regard it is to mention here that a public authority can provide information as defined in the term 'Information' under section 2(f) of RTI Act. Therefore information sought by the applicant do not come under the ambit of RTI Act. However with regard to point no.6, PIO, WR is directed to re-look upon the information sought and provide to the applicant, if available.

3.3 The instructions contained in the above order may be complied within 15 days of receipt of this order.

3.4 ORDER:

With the above observations, the Appeal dated 20.02.2025 of Smt. Padmaja Mishra hereby stands disposed off.
