1.0 PREAMBLE:

1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.

1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

2.1 Sh. Shivratan Deepchand Rai had submitted RTI application dated 09.11.2021 seeking information regarding '**No Objection Certificate issued for height clearance**

2.2 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 03.03.2025 before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai stating that Information sought is not received.

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

The appellant vide RTI application dated 15.03.2025 has sought information on 'NOC for Height clearance.

3.2 FINDINGS:

From the records produced it is seen that the appellant vide RTI application dated 15.03.2025 has sought information on 'NOC for Height clearance. In this regard vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-49/2025(एम)/58 dated 12.02.2025

it was informed to the applicant that NOC for height clearance is available in public domain vide NOCAS website "<http://nocas2.aai.aero/nocas/> under sublink Issued NOC's.

The applicant filed first appeal stating that Information sought is not received. In this regard it is seen that PIO has already informed appellant that information is available in public domain and also provided the website link to obtain information. Further it is to add here that RTI Act mandates every public authority to provide as much information to the public including through website so that the public have minimum resort to the use of RTI Act to obtain information. Further once information is provided in public domain i.e. available on website then the information is not required to be sought under 'right to information.'

Further, the above mentioned letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-49/2025(एम)/58 dated 12.02.2025 is uploaded on AAI website. The applicant is advised to refer the same on AAI website.

- 3.2 With this, the Appeal dated 03.03.2025 of Sh. Shivratn Deepchand Rai hereby stands disposed off.
