1.0 PREAMBLE

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Dr. Keshav Kshirsagar had submitted RTI application no. AAIMU/R/E/25/0059 dated 10.04.2025 to PIO, WR seeking information regarding 'Agreemets/MOU/order/letter or any other document issued by AAI to Ola, Ecab, prepaid taxi for allocation parking bay at Aeromall.
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-155/2025(एम)/120 dated 15.04.2025 returned RTI application to the applicant.
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/25/00013 dated 18.04.2025 before the First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ WR, Mumbai

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

1. Agreements/MOU/order/letter or any other document issued by AAI to Ola, Ecab, prepaid taxi for allocation parking bay at Aero mall.
2. Agreements/MOU/order/letter/notice or any other document issued to Aero mall administration or BVG group for collecting fines from no parking zones and towing vehicles in the premises of airport road.

3. Permission letters given to Ola, Uber, Sainath Taxi, Prepaid Auto Rickshaw services to display their advertisements / sign boards in the premises of airport Arrival sections at Terminal 2 and Terminal 1 and structure of advertisement fees taken from them.
4. Process of allocation of parking bays to Ola, Uber, Ecab, Sainath taxi, prepaid taxi .

3.2 **FINDINGS:**


The applicant vide RTI application dated has sought information regarding Agreements/MOU/order/letter or any other document issued by AAI to Ola, Ecab, prepaid taxi for allocation parking bay at Aeromall.

PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-155/2025(एम)/120 dated 15.04.2025 informed applicant that information sought in the RTI application are not clear/specific. Hence the RTI application is returned herewith. The applicant has filed first appeal on the ground that information sought is clear. The applicant stated that all questions are about Pune Airport.

On going through the RTI application is seen that applicant had not filed RTI application with precise details and therefore application was found to be ambiguous. Under RTI Act, public authority while providing information is not expected to interpret the information sought. Further it is also seen that applicant has added some particulars in the first appeal, which however is treated as new information. As per RTI Act, no additional/new information can be sought at appeal stage. In view of above it is comprehend that action taken is in consonance with RTI Act, accordingly no directions to PIO, WR are required in the matter.

3.3 **ORDER:**

With the above observations, the Appeal AAIMU/A/E/25/00013 dated 18.04.2025 Sh. Keshav Kshirsagar hereby stands disposed off.
