1.0 PREAMBLE

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Sh. Vikas Zine had submitted RTI application no. AAIMU/R/E/25/00039 dated 09.03.2025 to PIO, WR seeking information regarding Recruitment advertisement Western Region Advertisement no. DR-01/02/2025/WR.
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-106/2025(एम)/97 dated 28.03.2025 informed that 'The information sought is in questionnaire form which does not fall under the purview of RTI Act, 2005.'
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/25/00015 dated 21.04.2025 before the First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ WR, Mumbai

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :


- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :
Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:
 - 1) How many Application form received for the post of POST CODE 5 - JUNIOR ASSISTANT (FIRE SERVICES)(NE-04)
 - 2) How many CATEGORY WISE Application form received for the post of POST CODE 5 - JUNIOR ASSISTANT (FIRE SERVICES)(NE-04)
 - 3) How many WOMEN CANDIDATES Application form received for the post of POST CODE 5 - JUNIOR ASSISTANT (FIRE SERVICES)(NE-04)
 - 4) How many CATEGORY WISE WOMEN CANDIDATES Application form received for the post of POST CODE 5 - JUNIOR ASSISTANT (FIRE SERVICES)(NE-04)

3.2 FINDINGS:

The applicant vide RTI application dated has sought information regarding Recruitment advertisement Western Region Advertisement no. DR-01/02/2025/WR. PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-106/2025(एम)/97 dated 28.03.2025 informed that 'The information sought is in questionnaire form which does not fall under the purview of RTI Act, 2005.' The applicant has filed first appeal on the ground, Refused access to information requested. In this regard it would be pertinent to mention here that a citizen has a 'Right to Information' under the RTI Act. As such a citizen has a right to get information from a public authority which is held by it or which held under its control. However, a public authority is not supposed to answer interrogative queries, as it do not come under the ambit of RTI act. The public authority can only provide information as defined in the term 'Information' under section 2 (f) of RTI Act.

It is also seen that applicant has sought information in a specific format, but under RTI act no information is prepared or generated in a particular way for providing information to the applicant.

In view of above, no directions are required to be given to PIO, WR in the matter.
