1.0 PREAMBLE:

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 **Deepti Shah** had submitted RTI application dated 15.04.2025 seeking information regarding The list of all flight cancellations operated by Alliance Air
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/RTI/Case-160/25(M)/125 dated 21.04.2025 transferred RTI application to Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. to provide information directly to the applicant.
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 05.06.2025 before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai stating that “Information not received .”

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

As per AIRAC AIP SUPPLEMENT 137/2024 dated 30th May 2024 file no. ATN 19013/1/2024-atm 30.5.2024 CSI Airport, length of runway 09/27 & 14/32 displaced due to obstacles

Gilbert Hill is permanent obstacle or permanent obstacle

Mobile rail traffic is permanent obstacle or temporary obstacle on the approach of runway 09 at CSI Airport.

3.2 **FINDINGS:**


With the records produced it is observed that applicant vide RTI application has sought information regarding The list of all flight cancellations operated by Alliance Air. As per Section 6(3) of RTI Act, the RTI application was transferred to Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. The applicant filed first appeal stating that improperly the RTI application was transferred to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport instead of Alliance Air.

In this regard it is pertinent to mention here that Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport is operated by Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. The information pertaining to Alliance Air is not available with AAI and whereas it is more closely related to MIAL. Therefore as per Section 6(3) of RTI Act, the RTI application was transferred to Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd.

Thus PIO, WR has appropriately transferred RTI application to Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. as per provisions of RTI Act. therefore no directions are required to be given to PIO, WR in the matter.

3.3 **ORDER:**

With the above observations, the Appeal dated 05.06.2025 of Appellant hereby stands disposed off.
