1.0 PREAMBLE:

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 **Anita Aunkush Kunte** had submitted RTI application dated 15.03.2025 seeking information regarding displacement of runway due to obstacles at CSI Airport.
- 2.2 PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/RTI/Case-124/25(M)/133 dated 25.04.2025 transferred RTI application to Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. to provide information directly to the applicant.
- 2.3 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 24.04.2024 (received on 26.04.2024) before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai stating that "Information not received."

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

As per AIRAC AIP SUPPLEMENT 137/2024 dated 30th May 2024 file no. ATN 19013/1/2024-atm 30.5.2024 CSI Airport, length of runway 09/27 & 14/32 displaced due to obstacles

Gilbert Hill is permanent obstacle or permanent obstacle

Mobile rail traffic is permanent obstacle or temporary obstacle on the approach of runway 09 at CSI Airport.


3.2 FINDINGS:

With the records produced it is observed that applicant vide RTI application has sought information regarding Airport displacement of runway due to obstacles at CSI Airport.

The RTI application was forwarded to GM(ATM), Mumbai. Vide email dated 17.04.2025 it was informed by GM (ATM), Mumbai that sought information may be available with Airport Operator MIAL (Mumbai International Airport Limited). Therefore informing applicant the RTI application was transferred to MIAL u/s 6(3) of RTI Act. The applicant has filed first appeal stating that more than 30 days passed but no reply received. In this regard it is seen that since information is not available with AAI, and pertains to MIAL, therefore RTI application was transferred, with an intimation to the applicant to liaise with the O/o MIAL. As the CSI Airport is operated by MIAL, therefore information sought by the applicant is neither held nor is under the control of AAI. Under RTI Act the public authority can provide available recorded information only. The PIO has dealt RTI application as per provisions of RTI Act, therefore no directions are necessary to be given to PIO, WR in the matter.

3.3 ORDER:

With the above observations, the Appeal dated 09-05.2025 (received on 14.05.2025) of **Anita Aunkush Kunte** hereby stands disposed off.
