1.0 PREAMBLE:

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS:

- 2.1 Sh. Ravikant Shukla had submitted RTI application dated 11.04.2025 seeking information regarding CASO policy (Volume-III).
- 2.2 The Appellant filed first Appeal dated 18.07.2025 (received on 21.07.2025) before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ, Mumbai.

3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

1. Entire copy of CASO policy
2. Height rules for structures around Helipad and Heliport

3.2 FINDINGS:

With the records produced it is observed that vide RTI application dated applicant has sought entire copy of CASO policy and in accordance with this policy the applicant has sought height rules for structures around Helipad and Heliport.

In this regard Jt. GM (Security), WR and GM (ATM), WR informed that sought information does not pertain to their deptts. The reply received from these deptts. was provided to the applicant vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआई/केस-228/2025/(एम)/209/205 dated 13.06.2025.


In this regard it is seen that the reply provided by PIO, WR is a fact-based as AAI issues NOC to the structures in respect of licenced Civil Aerodromes and not for Heliport or Helipad.

However, since DGCA is the concerned public authority for licensing and operations of helipad/heliport, therefore PIO, WR is directed to transfer RTI application to DGCA u/s 6(3) of RTI Act informing applicant to liase with the O/o DGCA.

Instructions contained in the above order is to be complied within 15 days of receipt of this order.

3.3 ORDER:

With the above observations, the Appeal dated 18.07.2025 (received on 21.07.2025) of Appellant hereby stands disposed off.
