### **1.0 PREAMBLE**

- 1.1 This Order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067.
- 1.3 The Appeal can be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

### **2.0 FACTS:**

- 2.1 Sh. **Ashish Shankar** had submitted RTI application no. AAIMU/R/E/24/00110 dated 04.08.2024 to PIO, WR, RHQ, WR, Mumbai.
- 2.2 The Appellant filed first Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/24/00049 dated 19.11.2024 before First Appellate Authority, AAI, RHQ WR, Mumbai.

### **3.0 FINDINGS & ORDER :**

- 3.1 Having gone through the Appeal, the RTI application and the supply of information details, the case is summarised as under :

Brief of the RTI application filed by the appellant:

Life of Hon. PM in danger. CIA Agent in the PMO-Jaichand.

CIA is threatening the nation and traitors can attach the Hon.PM anytime.


### 3.2 FINDINGS:

From the records produced it is observed that PIO, WR vide letter no. 52042/आरटीआय/केस-341/2024(एम)/217 dated 07/16.08.2024 informed applicant that information sought under RTI Act is not clear therefore, the RTI application is returned herewith.'

On going through the RTI application and appeal it is seen that applicant has not sought information as defined u/s 2 (f) of RTI Act. The applicant has not clearly and specifically mentioned as to what information he is seeking under RTI Act. Therefore said RTI application do not come under the ambit of RTI Act. Hence PIO, WR has rightly rejected RTI application.

### 3.3 ORDER:

With the above observations, the Appeal no. AAIMU/A/E/24/00049 dated 19.11.2024 of Sh. Ashish Shankar hereby stands disposed off.
