

1.	What steps has the Airport Authority taken for the safety of the aircraft from the birds attracted by the meat garbage?	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Periodic inspection is being undertaken by AAI to ensure proper disposal of meat garbage generated from the butcheries and fish markets to avoid bird attraction. In case of any contravention in this matter, the same is being taken up with concerned Municipal administration to curb such activities and monitor the compliance.2. AEMC meetings are held with all concerned, to discuss measures for ensuring safe aircraft operations.3. Public awareness materials distributed among the surrounding community.4. Stringent Bird hazard control measures have been implemented to control or eradicate the sources of bird attraction in and around airfield.
2.	How many surveys, checks have been conducted to find out the number of slaughterhouses present within a 20km radius that violates the rules?	06 no. of surveys/checks have been conducted for the last one year.
3.	How many slaughterhouses have been found violating the guidelines and what were the actions taken against the offenders?	Only One slaughter house falls within the 10 km radius of Chennai Airport located at Saidapet which is approved by Ministry of Animal Husbandry of Government of Tamil Nadu and maintained by Greater Corporation of Chennai.

4.	Has any fatality or accident taken place due to the same reason?	No such accidents occurred in Chennai Airport.
5.	How has extending the radius helped and under what factors has the extension been implemented?	The extension of radius will be decided by MoCA.
