

5.	How much is the rate for Rapid PCR test in Tamilnadu Airports?	Rs. 3400/- per passenger for Chennai Airport
6.	Was there any tender notification issued for doing Rapid PCR test in Kerala and Tamilnadu Airports (for UAE Passengers)?	No tender notification issued with respect to Chennai Airport
7.	If yes, How many labs attended in that tender?	N/A
8.	Provide the date,venue,of the tender . Name and address of the Labs attended in that tender notification?	N/A
