Sir,

Reference your online RTI Request No. AAOIN/R/T/25/00202 dt. 06.05.2025, seeking information under RTI Act, 2005. The information sought at Sl. No. 1, 4 & 7 regarding Overflight Fee Structure, Landing and Aircraft Parking charges only pertains to JVC / Tariff Deptt. Further, information sought at Sr. No. 6 may be obtained from Engg. Dte. of AAI and other information sought at Sr. No.2, 3 & 5 is neither available nor maintained in the Joint Venture Cell of Airports Authority of India ("AAI"). However, it is also observed that the information sought at Sr.No. 2, 3 and 5 pertains to more than one (1) other Public Authorities, i.e., Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA), DGCA.
