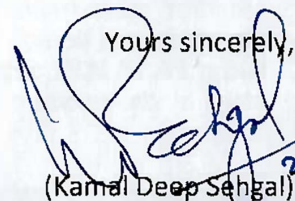
Reference may kindly be made to your First Appeal dated 06.08.2025 made against RTI request dated 05.06.2025 which has been Transferred on 25.06.2025 and received in this section on 26.06.2025, seeking information under RTI Act, 2005. The above appeal was disposed of vide this office order# AAI/MC/JVC/RTI/Appeal/2020-21/1741 dated 22.08.2025.

As per First Appeal order dated 22.08.2025, RTI reply provided by the GM (F), (Joint Venture Cell) // CPIO, vide this office letter dated 08.07.2025 was not given as per RTI Act, 2005 and hence it is set aside. CPIO is directed to dispose of the application as RTI Act, 2005, within a period of 15 days from the First Appeal order date i.e. 22.08.2025. The revised reply is as under:

In case, the applicant is not satisfied with the reply, he/she may file an appeal to the Mr. L Kuppulingam, Executive Director (PPP/JVC), First Appellate Authority, Airports Authority of India (AAI), Joint Venture Cell, C – Block, Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, Safdarjung Airport, New Delhi-110003, under section 19(1) of the RTI Act within the time limit specified in the RTI Act.
