1.0 PREAMBLE

- 1.1 This order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
- 1.2 The Appeal against this order lies with the Central Information Commissioner, CIC Bhavan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067
- 1.3 The Appeal may be filed within 90 days from the date of which this order is made or is actually received.

2.0 FACTS

2.1 The Appellant, SH.M. SUBRAMANI, S/O. MUNUSAMY, No.3, 4TH STREET, MALANKANANDAPURAM, ZAMIN PALLAVARAM, CHENNAI -600 043, has filed an RTI Request dated 12/09/2024 seeking the following information (Copy enclosed):

1. Have you received the above letter? If yes, furnish the Xerox copy of noting of all the pages of action taken.
2. Is there any rule to submit the Police Verification Report while joining duty? If Yes, kindly confirm whether he has submitted the same.
3. Kindly furnish the Date & Year of Police Verification Report submitted to your office by V Haridos.
4. If wrong report submitted, information required whether you take legal action against him.

2.2 On receipt of the response from DPIO i.e. JGM (SEC)/CSO, the CPIO, Chennai Airport vide letter No.AAM/RTI/GM(Ops)/202425QB27/2024-25/179-180 dated 30/09/2024 has provided the reply accordingly. Hence, the RTI application dated 12.09.2024 is hereby disposed off.

2.3 Whereas, the Appellant has now made First Appeal dated 28/10/2024 to FAA, AAI, Chennai Airport received on 30.10.2024, requesting for the following information:

- "i) Airport Employee V.Haridos while joining the duty police verification it should be must.
- ii) If Yes, furnish the Xerox copy of police verification report.
- iii) If wrong report submitted by V. Haridos, what action should be taken against him."

3.0 OBSERVATIONS OF FAA:


On examination of the Appeal and the response of the CPIO, it is observed:

- 3.1 That the RTI Request has been replied by the CPIO on 30/09/2024 which is within the stipulated time period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the request.
- 3.2 That the CPIO has responded to the queries sought by the Appellant wherein DPIO has denied the receipt of the letter dated 12.08.2024 inadvertently considering it as compliant letter to Go – Air Cargo instead of the letter was addressed to Airports Authority of India, Chennai Airport.
- 3.3 That, moreover, no action can be taken on the complaint letter dated 12.08.2024 as it was against the Go – Air Cargo employee which doesn't have any administrative control under AAI.
- 3.4 That, the custodian of the information sought by the Appellant is Go – Air Cargo and being a private entity, the RTI Application cannot be transferred u/s 6(3) of RTI Act. Hence, the Appellant has to approach the Go-Air Cargo directly.

4.0 ORDER

4.1 In view of the above, the information sought by the Appellant cannot be provided by this Public Authority.

4.2 Accordingly, the above appeal of SH.M. SUBRAMANI dated 28/10/2024 is treated as disposed off.
