1.0 Preamble:

- 1.1** This order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act 2005.
- 1.2** An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110 067.
- 1.3** The appeal may be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 Brief facts of the Appeal:

- 2.1** Shri Ayan Ghosh, Flat-4D/1, Block-14/1, Sunny Seasons Housing Apartments, S.N. Ghosh Avenue, Kamalgazi, Pin : 700103 made RTI application dated 23/11/2025, seeking certain information.
- 2.2** The RTI application was responded by the CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata Airport vide letter No. AAC/RTI/2025/104 dated 02.12.2025.
- 2.3** The contents of said RTI application and the reply thereto by the CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata, is reproduced hereunder, for ease of reference :

Sl. No.	Information Sought.	Reply.
1.	Share any MoM or the actual MoU that has been signed between Kolkata Airport, Omega Enterprises and Uber India related to airport related charges which includes parking fee, pickup fee or anything else last year in Feb 2024.	No such record available.
2.	What kind of Charges Uber India is paying you on a daily basis per trip or per day or any kind? For example – pickup charges, parking charges, convenience charges etc.	Per Trip basis.
3.	What are the amount of such charges Uber India is paying you on a daily basis per trip or per day or any kind after MOU was signed to till now?	Rs.80/- (Eighty) per trip.

3.0 Having been dissatisfied with the said Reply dated 02.12.2025 of CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata, the Applicant/Appellant has now preferred the Appeal to the First Appellate Authority vide RTI Appeal Registration No. DIRKA/A/E/25/00012 dated 02/12/2025 on grounds "Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information" and stating that "1. For the first question, you mentioned that there is no such record. But the news of that whatever called partnership or MOU had already been published in leading newspaper articles. Then on what grounds, it has been denied now. Kindly state your stance on this. Also check the attached file then. If there is no such thing as MoU then kindly state this positively in all your social media and broadcasting channels. If you have old files regarding the matter in question I with any kind of validity then share it. 2. For question 2, it has been asked what type of charges Uber is paying you, is it Pickup charges, parking charges or what? 3. You mentioned the amount of charge. which 80 per trip but you did not mention whether it is parking charges of pickup charges. If there are any other type of charges Uber is paying you per trip then kindly state that too."

4.0 **Findings / Order:**

The undersigned has perused the RTI application dated 23/11/2025 filed by the Applicant/Appellant and the reply furnished by CPIO vide letter dated 02/12/2025. Hence there is no delay in furnishing the information to Applicant/Appellant by the CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata as per the provisions of RTI Act.

4.1 From the reply of Point No.1 (*no such records available*) by the CPIO, it is observed that the information sought was not supplied/provided to the Applicant/Appellant. However, First Appellate Authority is of the view that more efforts should be made on the part of CPIO to provide the information to the Applicant/Appellant and hereby directs the CPIO to provide the information/reply to the Query of Point No.1 as sought by the Applicant/Appellant as per the provisions of RTI Act, 2005.

4.2 From the reply of Point No.2 & 3 by the CPIO, it is observed that the information has been supplied/provided to the Applicant/Appellant stating 'Per Trip' basis and the amount i.e. Rs.80/- per trip which is quite evident that it is pick-up charges.

4.3 Accordingly, the Applicant/Appellant's Appeal dated 02.12.2025 stands disposed.
