1.0 Preamble:

- 1.1** This order is made under Section-19 of the Right to Information Act 2005.
- 1.2** An appeal against this order lies with Central Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi – 110 067.
- 1.3** The appeal may be filed within 90 days from the date on which this order should have been made or is actually received.

2.0 Brief facts of the Appeal:

- 2.1** Sh. Kinkar Das, New Mahespur, PO – Mokdumpur, Malda, Pin : 732103 made an on line RTI application No. DIRKA/R/E/26/00003 dated 15.01.2026, received by AAI, Kolkata Airport on 15.01.2026 seeking certain information.
- 2.2** The RTI application has been responded by the CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata Airport vide letter No. AAC/RTI/2026/19 dated 13.02.2026.
- 2.3** The RTI application and the reply thereto furnished by the CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata, are reproduced hereunder, for ease of reference :

3.0 Being dissatisfied with the reply of CPIO, AAI, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata, the Applicant/Appellant has now preferred the online Appeal to the First Appellate Authority vide No. DIRKA/A/E/26/00001 dated 05.03.2026 on the ground 'Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information', stating that "1. In the RTI reply, it is stated that DBT was not processed from July to October 2025. Kindly provide the officials records and file noting indicating reasons for not including the month of November 2025. 2. Name and designation of the officer/authority with whom the file relating to my DBT and resignation approval is presently pending. 3. Certified copy of the complete file noting/order sheet indicating reasons for delay/holding of the file and action taken so far."

4.0 **Findings / Order:**

The undersigned on perusal of the RTI application dated 15.01.2026 filed by the Applicant and reply furnished by the CPIO vide letter dated 13.02.2026 (along with Annexure 'A'), has observed that there is no delay in the submission of the information as per RTI provisions.

4.1 From the reply of the CPIO, it is observed that the Applicant/Appellant has been furnished with the detailed and complete information by the CPIO in the form of Annexure 'A'.

4.2 In view of the above facts and circumstances, it appears that there is no infirmity in the manner of disposal of the RTI application dated 15.01.2026 by the CPIO.

4.3 However, it is observed that the Applicant vide appeal dated 05.03.2026 has actually sought additional information for which the applicant may make a fresh RTI Application.

4.4 Accordingly, the Appellant's appeal dated 05.03.2026 stands disposed of.
