


Reference is invited to RTI Application of Sh. [Redacted] received online vide Registration No. AAOIN/R/E/24/00528 dated 18/02/2024.

2. In this regard, the point-wise reply of the information sought in the above said RTI is as under:

S. No.	Information Sought	Reply
1	Any possibility is there for AAI employees to Switch from pension option (B) to Pension option (N) or vice versa after a certain period of service.	It is informed that Airports Authority of India is covered under the ambit of Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952. All employees of AAI are being granted PF and Pensionary Benefits in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Schemes within the Act. These are available in public domain.
2	If it is possible then provide the conditions under which such a switch may be permissible and the process involved in initiating such a change.	
3	Once an employee exercised the option to switch from pension option (B) to pension option (N) after 5 years of services, then the fund deducted in accordance with option (B) (i.e. 1250 rupees every month for 60-month total is 75000) will be transferred to EPF or it will be transferred to Employee. Provide the rules and regulations under which this 75,000-rupee fund will be managed.	

3. In case you are not satisfied with above reply an appeal against this lies with ED (Admin) and First Appellate Authority, AAI, CHQ, A Block, Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, Safdarjung Airport, New Delhi 110 003 within 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter.
