Out of the total disputes, 13.33% of disputes were referred to arbitration pertaining to Department of Engineering (Civil & Electrical) at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata.
Out of the total number of disputes where the Ministry of Civil Aviation or its departments PSUs or organisations was a party what percentage were referred to arbitration in each of the last five financial years.	In respect of Department of Commercial, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata, no matter has been referred to, for Arbitration.
In each of the last five financial years what was the percentage share of arbitration cases involving the Ministry or its associated departments PSUs or bodies in the total number of arbitrations conducted in India as per records available with your Ministry.
