The RTI information sought vide Registration AAION /R/2019/80169 dated 03 JUN 2019 and received vide CHQ letter no PERS/RC/RTI/2018/41 dated June 27 is given below.: The reply as follows

Question	Reply
1 Reservation of vacancies for Ex-Servicemen in Group C posts in PSU is validated by the OM No.DPE 20(10)/99-DPE-GM-Part-2014-FTS-1517 issued by Govt. of india, Ministry of Heavy Industries & public Enterprises dated 25.02.2015. It states that quote instructions as issued by Govt. in respect of reservation to SC, ST,OBC, Disability and Ex-Servicemen are to be taken as Mutatis mutandis & is extended to all the CPSE concerned unless specifically specified otherwise by DPE. Unquote.This OM was not followed by AAI Southern region as a result of which even a single Ex-Servicemen out of the 07 Ex-servicemen who had cleared both stages of the selection process for the Group C posts of JA (FS) was not included in the final selected list of 146 candidates. So ,provide the certified copy of the authorization document based on which Ex-servicemen quota as authorized by various OMs of GOI and the above mentioned OM of DPE was not provided when recruitment and finalization of selected candidates for the Group C post of JA (FS) was carried out by AAI-SR.	Question is repetitive in nature. Already answered Q7 of AAOIN/R/2019/50707 dated 16 th May 2019
2) As per reply to Query No. 3 & 4 of my RTI No. AAOIN/R/2019/50707, it was replied that quota AAI follows all the rules and regulations framed by the Central Government /DoPT with regard to the Ex-Servicemen Unquote. In that case, vacancies must have been reserved for Ex-Servicemen on the basis of which atleast 7 Ex-Servicemen candidates had cleared both the stages of the selection process for the Group C post of JA (FS) for which notification was published by AAI-SR vide SR/01/2018 but none of these Ex-Servicemen were included in the final list of 146 selected candidates. But at the same time, the total 146 vacancies were fully filled. If OM No. DPE 20(10)/99-GM-Part-2014-FTS-1517 dated 25.02.2015 is applicable to AAI-SR, provide the certified copy of the document based on which the vacancies which must have been reserved only for Ex-Servicemen were transferred to other candidates.

3)	AAI Notification F.No. AAI/PERS/EDPA/Reg/2002 in the Gazette of India Extraordinary pertaining to Ministry of Civil Aviation (Airports Authority of India) states vide Point No.6 regarding condition for appointment in the Authority. As per its Sub Point 6(2) it states Quote Nothing in these regulations will affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided to SC.ST.OBC, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons, in this regard Unquote. Provide the certified copy of the document based on which the above mentioned rule or regulation of AAI on reservation of vacancies for Ex-Servicemen was not followed when recruitment for the Group C posts of JA (FS) vide SR/01/2018 was conducted by AAI Southern Region.	Question is repetitive in nature. Already answered Q3&4 of AAI/CH/R/2019/50042 dated 29 th Apr 2019
4	AAI with the approval of the Central Government had made the R&P Regulations 2005 and had addressed it to RED, AAI, NR/WR/SR/WR/NER and also the Airport Director, AAI, IGI/Mumbai/NSCBI/ Chennai/TAP Airport vide No. PERS/MPP/1126/1/89(VI)/337 dated 08 June 2006. Point No. 12 of the reservations and concessions to SC/ST/OBC/ & Physically Challenged Persons which states that Quoted the directives of the Government concerning reservations of vacancies and concessions allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Ex-Servicemen, physically handicapped persons etc, as notified by Government from time to time will be strictly followed by the notified appointing authorities. Unquote. If point No. 12 of R&P Regulations 2005 pertaining to the directives of the Government concerning reservations of the vacancies to Ex-Servicemen as notified by Government from time to time was strictly followed by the notified appointing authorities of AAI-SR when the recruitment for the Group C post of JA (FS) was conducted, provide the certified copy of the document based on which the 7 Ex-Servicemen who had cleared both the stages of the selection process were not selected under Ex-Servicemen quota for the Group C post of JA (FS), for which notification was published vide SR/01/2018.	Question is repetitive in nature. Already answered Q3&4 of AAI/CH/R/2019/50042 dated 29 th Apr 2019
