Not more than 20% of space shall be demarcated for Govt. Vehicles/VIP Parking, and vehicles parked in this area shall be exempted from parking fees.

Not more than 20% of space shall be demarcated for Govt. Vehicles/VIP Parking, and vehicles parked in this area shall be exempted from parking fees.

SCHEDULE OF PARKING TARIFF

1. Parking fee will be charged from all vehicles entering the designated parking area, as detailed below:

a.) Introductory slab for up to 30 minutes to be implemented based on the category of the Airport:

Details*	In INR
Coach/Bus/Truck	50
Tempo/SUV/ Mini Bus	40
Car	40
Two Wheeler	20

Note: Proposed rates are inclusive of all taxes including GST, if applicable.

b) Rates as per existing slab will be applicable from 30 minutes to 120 minutes, the same is also reproduced below:

Details	(in INR)
Coach/Bus/Truck	110
Tempo/SUV/Minibus	110
Car	100
Two Wheeler	25

c) After two hours, rate will increase by Rs.20/- per hour. For two wheelers, the charge after 2 hours will be Rs.10/- per hour. The Parking rate beyond 7 hours upto 24 hours will be 300% of the 30 minutes to 120 minutes' slab and every 24 hours or part thereof. (as per existing rates)
