There is no concession agreement between AAI and Airport Operators, Bangalore International Airport Limited (BIAL) and Hyderabad International Airport Limited (HIAL).</p> <p>The information sought pertains to or closely related to functions of BIAL and HIAL, which are 3rd parties.</p> <p>Hence, the RTI request has been transferred to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of BIAL and HIAL with a request to provide the requisite information to the applicant directly under intimation to this Office.</p> <p>It is observed from the action history of RTI request that the RTI request has already been forwarded to the concerned CPIO for providing information in Chennai and Adani Ahmedabad International Airport Limited (AAIAL) by the Nodal Officer.</p>
