Sir,

Reference may kindly be made to your on-line RTI request # AAOIN/R/E/24/00045 dated 22.05.2024, which has been partly transferred from Northern Region for providing information under RTI Act, 2005.

On perusal of records in Joint Venture Cell of Airports Authority of India, it has been found that you had sought same information vide RTI request # AAOIN/R/E/24/00987 dated 09.04.2024. The said RTI request was transferred to Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) as the information sought pertains to or closely related to functions of DIAL, vide this office letter # AAI/359/2020-F&A-NR/1234 dated 10.04.2024. DIAL had provided the reply vide letter # DIAL/2024-25/SPG/2341 dated 16.04.2024 which was endorsed to you also.

Central Information Commission, in its various decisions, has stated that "The Commission holds that though RTI Act, did not specifically provide as a ground of refusing the information, it is implied from the objective and various provisions of RTI Act, that any citizen has right to information only once and not repeatedly." The Commission has observed that the citizens do not have a right to repeat the same or similar or slightly altered information request under RTI Act, 2005, for which he has already got response. Such repetition should be considered as a reasonable ground of refusal under the RTI Act. The CPIO of Public Authority should reject it forthwith after intimating it along with reasons.

Since, the reply has already been provided to you, the RTI requests referred above stand rejected.
